Topics for producing good choreography will include but not be limited to:

How to: choose, count & break down music into choreographic parts, use RAL phased figures & correct body mechanics, use highlights in the music to create memorable moments, match the choreography to a target audience, construct and proofread cue sheets.

What to bring to get the most out of the choreography school experience:

- Dance shoes – we will be dancing choreography as it is being produced
- Computer or other source for music (Access to YouTube would be very helpful)
- Earphones for working in the hall at the same time as others with different music (optional)
- A piece of music that you would be interested in using for choreography (optional)
- A piece of choreography of at least 8 measures, that you may have already written (optional)
- A list of questions that you might want answered during the school (optional)
- *No prior experience necessary. Do as much or as little preparation as is comfortable for you.

About the Bossier City/Shreveport area: *Make a real vacation out of it!*

- Closest airports include Shreveport Regional Airport, (American, United, Allegiant, Delta) with connections to Dallas, Los Angeles, Atlanta
- Dallas is 188 miles and Little Rock is 215 miles from Bossier City
